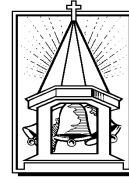
Brotherhood - Meets at 7 a.m. the 4th Sunday of each month in the Fellowship Hall.

“SOUL-FOOD - THE QUIET TIME”

The Bible is the written Word of God and is the revealed mind of God for every believer. It is the revelation of the person of Christ and the program of God. It is here that we find what He wants in our lives. Nothing is so important as the Word of God; therefore, it is important for every Christian to know that Word.

There are five distinct ways of getting to know the great truths contained in the Scriptures.

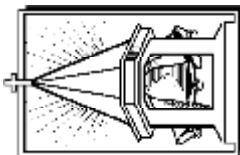
1. through the **hearing** of the preached Word (Romans 10:17).
2. through the **reading** of the printed page (1 Timothy 4:13).
3. through **studying** of the Scriptures (2 Timothy 2:15).
4. through **meditating** upon verses of Scripture (Joshua 1:8).
5. through **memorizing** portions of the Bible (Psalm 119:11).

None of these ways of learning God's Word is sufficient in itself. Each one is specifically mentioned in the Bible, and each is necessary for a balanced intake and understanding of Scripture.

The following remarks are designed to help you learn how to establish a regular “soul-feeding” time and to help you find the mind of God for your everyday life.

1. Carve out 7 minutes a day for time **alone** with your Bible and the Lord.
2. Keep a pencil or pen and a notebook handy. Write in your Bible and notebook as you desire.
3. Before you begin reading your Bible, ask the Lord to make your reading meaningful (and expect Him to do it).
4. If you do not already have a definite plan for reading, begin with The Gospel of John, followed by The Epistle to the Romans, then Genesis. By the time you have finished Genesis, you will be capable of formulating your own plan.

5. Read with the idea of finding one thing for meditation and reflection during the day - something you may apply or use in some way.
6. Look for specifics: examples to follow, duties to perform, errors to avoid, promises to claim, prayer to echo.
7. Meditate and reflect upon what comes to your attention.
8. Thank the Lord for supplying the specific "soul-food" for that day.
9. Write the specifics in your notebook.
10. Ask the Lord's guidance for the activities in your calendar for the rest of the day.
11. During the day, share the food with someone.
